Rejuvenating your tired spaces with new vitality, greater function, and added beauty

Interior Redesign is the practice of transforming an existing space within your home, using the furnishings you already own.

Are you having a hard time arranging your old furnishings in your new home? Maybe you need a room to function differently. Perhaps you're just ready for a change. Interior redesign is a cost effective method of creating new looks and greater functionality in the rooms of your home by simply altering how existing furnishings are used.

Why is redesigning a room a good idea?

- Buying new furnishings for your home is cost prohibitive.
- You really love the pieces you currently own and want to keep them.
- Lives have changed but your rooms haven't "kept up" with the changes; for example a play-room needs to be an office or a spare bedroom needs to become a nursery.
- Your decorating tastes have changed; maybe you once loved country but now you'd like a more traditional feel or maybe you're ready to add color to your neutral walls.
- You've just moved and now your existing furnishings aren't working as well as you'd like them to in your new home or you'd just like help with initial furniture placement in your new home.

What exactly happens during a redesign?

Stage 1 – Initial Meeting at space to be redesigned

- We'll discuss the look, feel, and function you are striving to achieve in the space we are redesigning.
- We'll walk together through you home so we know what furnishings are available to us.
- We'll take "before" pictures of the space we are redesigning.

Stage 2 - Planning Stage

- We'll create a "punch list" of pre-work activities that need to be completed prior to the redesign. In addition to removing all items from the room, there may be additional tasks that need to occur such as moving large pieces of furniture into the space from another room, painting, or cleaning.
- We'll establish an action plan to aid you in completing the punch list.
- We'll set a redesign date.

Stage 3 – The Redesign

- We'll work together to move furnishings (furniture, accessories, window treatments, etc.) back into the room to meet your redesign goals for look, feel, and function.
- We'll create a list of any "holes" that were created in other rooms in your home as a result of moving pieces into the redesigned space.
- We'll create a list of any smaller items to be purchased for the redesigned room, and we'll
 make suggestions of possible locations for easy purchase.
- We'll take "after" pictures of the space we redesigned.

We also offer shopping services geared toward finding cost effective pieces to complement your redesign plan. Shopping services are billed at an hourly rate. Stage 1 typically takes approximately 1 hour. Stages 2 and 3 greatly vary based on the size of the space, the extent of the change, and the level of pre-work completed by the client from the punch list.
